509.1 ADMISSIONS TO PUBLIC SCHOOL

I. PURPOSE

All schools supported in whole or part by state funds are public schools. Admission to a public school, except a technical institute, is free to any person who resides within the district, which operates the school, who is under 21 years of age, and who satisfies the minimum age requirements imposed by this section.

No person shall be admitted to any public school, (1) as a kindergarten pupil, unless the pupil is at least five years of age on September 1 of the calendar year in which the school year for which the pupil seeks admission commences; or (2) as a first grade student, unless the pupil is at least six years of age on September 1 of the calendar year in which the school year for which the pupil seeds admission commences or has completed kindergarten.

The School District/kindergarten teacher may request evidence of immunizations and a birth certificate at the time of registration/admission.
